Dear Parents

Greetings from DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL Nadergul.

We welcome you warmly to an enriching academic session at Delhi Public School, Nadergul.

As the vision of the school suggests we wish to foster academic excellence, promote co-curricular growth, develop a scientific temper and instill in children values that would lead to holistic development in all areas of learning. Thus leading them to the true meaning of our motto” Service before self”.

As the new session begins we wish to apprise all parents about the new initiatives that the school has taken for this academic session.

1. The school has the honor of being associated with “**British Council**” towards the **International School Award**. All students of grades 1 – 7 would be actively participating in this yearlong activity.
2. In collaboration with **British Council** school is also offering the “**Reading Challenge Program**” for selected students.
3. In association with **Trinity college of London**, the school would be taking up the **GESE – (Graded Examinations in Spoken English)**. (A detailed circular would be reaching you soon.)
4. All students of grades 3, 4 & 5 would be receiving the **Times NIE** newspaper in education while students of grades 6 & 7 will be receiving **The Hindu NIE**. We wish that students use this tool to hone their language skills and be in touch with latest news all over the world.
5. Every class would be receiving a **Vocabulary Calendar** month wise displayed in the class rooms. A “**Spell Bee**” every month would be conducted on the same word list given in the vocabulary calendar. The vocabulary calendar would be uploaded in the school website for parent’s reference very soon.
6. School is also proposing a set of **20 Honor Badges** to be acquired by children as they display exemplary standards in all areas. Request parents to encourage your child to acquire these badges during the academic session.
7. Students of classes 3 – 7 will now have a Choice of **Sport & Activity to be picked** up in their timetable. This is to further train the child in areas of specific interest shown. (A circular to this effect will be reaching you soon.)

8. **After School Sports** and **After School Academics** would be starting from the month of July. Interested parents to contact respective coordinators.

9. An **After School Academic Enrichment Program** for students of grade 3 – 7 is also being planned only for selected students in the fields of Math & Science. The students would be selected on the basis of a standardized evaluation in math & science.

10. The school would be sending a **Log Sheet** every month which will contain the activities of the entire month for the perusal of parents.

11. There has been minor modifications in the examination pattern of grades 1 – 5 as per CBSE guide lines. However for grades 6 & 7 the examination system has been modified to a large extent. (A parent meet would be conducted on June 24th to apprise parents of this.)

12. School is proposing the start of a **II – Language “Sanskrit”** option for students of grades 1, 2 & 3. (Interested parents to contact the coordinators immediately.)

13. As already decided in the month of April one section in grade 5 and one section of grade 6 would be operating on **Smart Tab Learning Solutions**, using technology as a tool to further academic excellence.

14. School has also taken up an association with an educational software consultant and would soon be equipped with projectors and software in each and every classroom.

We wish to inform you all these new initiatives have been taken up with a primary motive of giving children the best in academics, sports, co-curricular activities and other areas of learning.
